

General Information on the FM Transmitter in the Church

The church is now equipped with a stereo audio system that broadcasts on the FM band. It enables hearing-impaired parishioners inside of the church to tune their digital FM receivers in order to receive the sound from our church service. Those wishing to avail themselves of this service must bring their own digital FM receivers with earphones.

You will require a portable MP3 players **with FM radio** that you can preset to the church frequency of 90.5 Mhz on the FM band.

A number of different portable MP3 players are sold in Montreal stores and include Sansa, Sony and Apple. Always look for an MP3 player with FM radio.

We recommend the Sansa Clip Plus as it is a small 1" x 2" MP3 player with an FM radio. It retails for about \$39.

If you currently own an Ipod Nano, it will pick up the parish FM signal. However, it is the most expensive unit on the market at about \$160.
